The Birmingham Airport Authority (BAA) will conduct a Public Involvement Meeting concerning the following proposed project:

Redevelopment Land Use Plan

The Birmingham Airport Authority has hired Volkert & Associates, Inc. (Volkert) to develop a land use plan for approximately 600 acres of land adjacent to the Birmingham-Shuttlesworth International Airport acquired through their noise mitigation program. This land was acquired through grants from the Federal Aviation Administration with assurances that this land would be redeveloped with uses compatible with the noise levels generated by the Airport. This final series of public input meetings will be used to discuss the project and present the final plan.

Two open-house format meetings will be held. The first will be from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.. The second will be from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The same exhibits and information will be presented at each meeting. Attendees are welcome to walk around the room to look at maps and graphics of the study area.

There will be no formal presentation at either meeting. Information packets, which include a comment form, will be provided to you at the sign-in table. Representatives from the Birmingham Airport Authority and the Volkert Team will be present to explain the maps, scope of the project and answer your questions about the project.
